PETITION FOR REGULAR VARIANCE  
AND WAIVER OF FEES ON CONSENT  
CALENDAR

1 With regard to Petitioner's Internal Combustion Engine ("ICE") used as an emergency  
2 back-up generator in the Angeles National Forest at APN 8675 016-307, Claremont, CA 91711  
3 ("ESR"), Facility ID No. 193436, the Los Angeles Regional Interoperable Communications  
4 System Authority ("Petitioner") and the South Coast Air Quality Management District ("South  
5 Coast AQMD" or "Respondent") (collectively, the "Parties") hereby request that Case No. 6234-5,  
6 the Petition for a Regular Variance and Fee Waiver ("Petition") scheduled for a public hearing on  
7 April 23, 2025 at 9:30 AM, be placed on that date's consent calendar. Pursuant to Hearing Board  
8 Rule 4(a), the Parties stipulate to the following:

9 1. The Parties agree to have the matter placed on the consent calendar for  
10 April 23, 2025 at 9:30 AM.

11 2. The Parties agree that the Declaration of Ted Pao (filed concurrently herewith)  
12 shall be admitted into evidence.

13 3. The Parties agree that all prior evidence in this matter, including from the decision  
14 to grant an Interim Variance, and all previously submitted exhibits shall be incorporated by  
15 reference into this hearing.

16 4. The Parties have agreed on the [Proposed] Findings and Decision and Order  
17 Granting a Regular Variance and Waiver of Fees (the "[Proposed] Order") (filed concurrently  
18 herewith).

19 5. The South Coast AQMD does not oppose granting the regular variance.

20 6. The South Coast AQMD does not oppose granting the fee waiver under South  
21 Coast AQMD Rule 303(p) given the extreme wind conditions and wildfires in January 2025, of  
22 which the wind conditions and wildfires were part of an event to be declared a "state of  
23 emergency" by local, state, or federal authorities on or about January 7, 2025.

24 7. Petitioner's operation under the [Proposed] Order is not expected to result in a  
25 violation of Health and Safety Code Section 41700 / South Coast AQMD Rule 402.

26 8. The Parties may execute and deliver this Stipulation by transmitting an authorized  
27 signature by fax or .pdf document. Copies of this Stipulation signed and delivered by means of  
28

1 faxed signatures or signatures in a .pdf document shall have the same effect as copies executed  
2 and delivered with original signatures.
