1 With regard to Petitioner's Internal Combustion Engine ("ICE") used as an emergency
2 back-up generator in the Angeles National Forest at 10875U Santa Clara Truck Trail, Canyon
3 Country, CA 91390 (also known as "Magic Mountain Link" or "MML"), Facility ID No. 195322,
4 the Los Angeles Regional Interoperable Communications System Authority ("Petitioner") and the
5 South Coast Air Quality Management District ("South Coast AQMD" or "Respondent")
6 (collectively, the "Parties") hereby request that Case No. 6234-7, the Petition for an Interim
7 Variance and Fee Waiver ("Petition") scheduled for a public hearing on May 27, 2025 at 9:30 AM,
8 be placed on that date's consent calendar. Pursuant to Hearing Board Rule 4(a), the Parties
9 stipulate to the following:

10 1. The Parties agree to have the matter placed on the consent calendar for May
11 27, 2025 at 9:30 AM.

12 2. The Parties agree that the Declaration of Nancy Yang (filed concurrently herewith)
13 shall be admitted into evidence.

14 3. The Parties agree that all prior evidence in this matter, including from the decision
15 to grant an Emergency Ex Parte Variance, 2025 Proclamation of a State of Emergency, and all
16 previously submitted exhibits shall be incorporated by reference into this hearing.

17 4. The Parties have agreed on the [Proposed] Findings and Decision and Order
18 Granting an Interim Variance and Waiver of Fees (the "[Proposed] Order") (filed concurrently
19 herewith).

20 5. The South Coast AQMD does not oppose granting the interim variance.

21 6. The South Coast AQMD does not oppose granting the fee waiver under South
22 Coast AQMD Rule 303(p) given the extreme wind conditions and wildfires in January 2025, of
23 which the wind conditions and wildfires were part of an event to be declared a "state of
24 emergency" by local, state, or federal authorities on or about January 7, 2025.

25 7. Petitioner's operation under the [Proposed] Order is not expected to result in a
26 violation of Health and Safety Code Section 41700 / South Coast AQMD Rule 402.

27 8. The Parties may execute and deliver this Stipulation by transmitting an authorized
28 signature by fax or .pdf document. Copies of this Stipulation signed and delivered by means of

1 faxed signatures or signatures in a .pdf document shall have the same effect as copies executed
2 and delivered with original signatures.
