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i would also like to ask the following questions of both parties and offer the following comments for the public record:

- would it be possible to conduct the next AQMD Hearing Board Status / Modification Hearing regarding the Lineage clean-up efforts within 60 days in Boyle Heights, as requested by members of the Public and City, County, and State Officials?
- would it be possible to hold virtual and in-person weekly informational meetings in the community to provide timely updates and the opportunity for community feedback, as requested by members of the Public?
- is it possible to include schools, childcare facilities, senior care facilities, and healthcare facilities in the Community Communication Plan including via the notification system, also as requested by the Public and City, County, and State Officials?
- is it possible for all food waste to be removed by Wednesday, August 12, 2026, as requested by the Public and City, County, and State Officials -- before the start of the school year?
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- thank you for amending the proposed order to include signage in Spanish and other languages, as appropriate, as requested by the Public and City, County, and State Officials.
- thank you for addressing the Community's concerns about noise mitigation, particularly during early morning hours and nighttime.
- thank you for including the request from members of the Public and City, County, and State Officials request for Fenceline Monitoring.
- thank you for proposing maximum fines in order to support funding critical and time-sensitive needs of the communities most harmed including: air purifiers, air conditioners, masks, smoke /

toxics / odor / food waste cleaning, housing relocation, financial assistance to cover increased energy costs, and additional financial assistance for other critical needs to those members of the Community most impacted and most at-risk.

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again, thank you once again to all parties involved for addressing these urgent needs and concerns by members of the Public, especially those most harmed and at-risk.
