

1 2. In 2007, I earned a bachelor's degree in business administration from California State
2 University Long Beach. In 2013, I earned a master's degree in business administration from the
3 University of La Verne. I have been with SCE since 2011. My current responsibilities at SCE
4 include portfolio management and strategic initiatives for Catalina Island's electric grid. Before
5 joining SCE, I worked at Raytheon Company starting in 2007, where I managed Department of
6 Defense contracts.

8 3. SCE has complied with the requirements listed in paragraph 1 on pages 15 of the Hearing
9 Board's order dated November 19, 2025. Specifically:

10 **Requirement:** Respondent shall begin negotiations with the preferred vendor to
11 work toward a purchase order for the selected unit.

- 12 • **SCE Response:** SCE has begun preliminary discussions with the
13 preferred vendor but is not yet in a position to negotiate the purchase
14 order (see No.2 below).

15
16 **Requirement:** If necessary, Respondent shall request an exemption from U.S. EPA
17 allowing Cummins to sell a Tier 2-certified unit to SCE for baseload generation.

- 18 • **SCE Response:** SCE submitted the exemption request on Jan. 30, 2026.
19 SCE met with U.S. EPA staff and provided additional information in
20 response to staff questions. SCE has not yet received a response.

21 **Requirement:** Respondent shall prepare a revised application for a Permit to
22 Construct for the selected unit and submit it to the SCAQMD.

- 23 • **SCE Response:** SCE submitted a revised application for a Permit to
24 Construct for the selected unit on Dec. 19, 2025.

25
26 **Requirement:** Respondent shall provide an updated schedule to the SCAQMD for
27 compliance with Rule 1135 based on the acquisition of the preferred unit.

1 Respondent shall identify any necessary changes to Rule 1135 and communicate
2 them to the SCAQMD.

- 3 • **SCE Response:** At this time, there is no proposed change to the
4 schedule to the SCAQMD for compliance with Rule 1135 based on the
5 acquisition of the preferred unit. SCE will assess potential changes
6 based on the timing of the U.S. EPA exemption approval and the status
7 of its revised application for a Permit to Construct. At this time, SCE
8 has not identified any necessary changes to Rule 1135.
9

- 10 4. If U.S. EPA grants SCE's request for an exemption, SCE will resume negotiations with
11 Cummins to purchase the unit.
- 12 5. Operation under the proposed order is not expected to result in a violation of Health and
13 Safety Code Section 41700.
14
