We purchased our home in part due to the large yard that we envisioned our children playing in. We worked to turn it into a beautiful and safe place for our family. However, it is often unsafe for us to spend time out there. The fumes from the dump often make our yard unusable. I have concern regarding the long term health implications this will have on my growing children. They've lived here for the majority if not all of their lives and my sons who already have asthma are at a greater risk. The proposal to add toxic ash to the already poorly managed dump is infuriating. It will directly impact our health and safety as well as our property values. We are to believe that the dump who cannot properly handle regular waste effectively are now to be trusted with toxic ash.
