**TIMELINE IN SUPPORT OF REGULAR
VARIANCE**

16 In support of the petition for Regular Variance, Petitioner prepared the following timeline of relevant
17 events in 2026:

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- 19 1. February 18, 2026 – The start of a series of SCE outage events that required emergency operation
20 of the generator. Those February outages caused the generator to accumulate more than 125
21 hours of operation.
 - 22 2. March 13, 2026 – Petitioner filed application for the subject emergency generator (Application
23 No. 666776).
 - 24 3. May 15-17, 2026 – New unanticipated SCE outages occur resulting in total operating hours for
25 the generator exceeding 200.
 - 26 4. May 19, 2026 – Petitioner filed ex parte emergency and interim variance petition.
 - 27 5. May 21, 2026 – Emergency variance issued.

- 1 6. May 26, 2026 – An SCE outage caused the generator to operate for 15.7 hours.
- 2 7. June 16, 2026 – Granting of interim variance.
- 3 8. June 17, 2026 – Another SCE outage caused the generator to operate for 3.12 hours bringing the
- 4 total number of accumulated operating hours to just over 220.
- 5 9. July 28, 2026 – Hearing on regular variance scheduled.
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
