

NOTICE OF HYBRID PUBLIC HEARING
TO CONSIDER THE GRANTING OF A VARIANCE AND
THE ADOPTION OF A COMPLIANCE DATE

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the South Coast Air Quality Management District (South Coast AQMD) Hearing Board will hold a public hearing at 9:30 a.m. on **TUESDAY, JULY 21, 2026**, to consider the granting of a regular variance from **Rules 203, 1147, and 2004** of the South Coast AQMD Rules and Regulations and the adoption of a final compliance date for a rotary dryer and a regenerative thermal oxidizer (RTO) at **RECONSERVE OF CALIFORNIA – LOS ANGELES, INC., 9112 Graham Avenue, Los Angeles, California 90002**. Rule 203 requires a permit to operate and requires operation in accordance with specified conditions of said permit. Rule 1147 controls oxides of nitrogen (NO_x) and carbon monoxide (CO) emissions from gaseous liquid fuel fired combustion equipment as defined in the rule. Rule 2004 requires that the holder of a facility permit comply at all times with the rules and permit conditions applicable to the facility. The nature and extent of estimated excess emissions are to be determined at the hearing.

The hearing will be conducted through a hybrid format, both in person at the South Coast AQMD, 21865 Copley Drive, Diamond Bar, CA 91765, Hearing Board Room and virtually via videoconference and by telephone. Members of the public will have the opportunity to provide public comments or testimony either in person or virtually.
