

Role of Carl Moyer Program Incentives





What is the Carl Moyer Program?

 A voluntary grant program targeting the replacement of older, heavy-duty diesel vehicles and equipment

What does the Carl Moyer Program Accomplish?

 Accelerates the commercialization of the cleanest technologies available



Carl Moyer Funding Sources







Smog Abatement Fee

Tire Fee

Local Match

Available funding for 2025 – Approximately \$46 Million



Key Program Updates and Reminders for 2025

Removed requirement for all projects to have 15% NOx reduction (excluding on-road projects)

Minimum contract term reduced to 1-Year

Off-Road agricultural projects will be evaluated on a default 10-year project life

>Authorization for funding projects up to date of compliance





Key Program Updates and Reminders for 2025 (cont.)

Promotion of Zero-Emission (ZE) technology projects

- Case-by-Case determinations no longer required from CARB
- Lease-to-own purchases will be permitted
- Extended timeframe for scrapping baseline equipment
- Expansion of eligible costs to include extended warranties, taxes, and insurance

Cost-Effectiveness

Standard Projects:

- Limit: \$60,000 per weighted ton of emissions reduced
- Scope: Projects updating vehicles and equipment to current standards

Zero-Emission & Cleanest Standard Projects

- Limit: \$522,000 per weighted ton of emissions reduced pending CARB approval
- Scope: Projects that are zero-emission or meet the cleanest certified optional standard (by source category

Variable Cost-Effectiveness

• Subject to change based on additional program requirements

Determination Formula

• Based on annualized project cost and reductions in NOx, ROG, and PM10 emissions

Elements of a Complete Vendor Quote:

- Equipment/Engine Cost
- Sales Tax
- Warranty Info
- Engine Year, HP, & Tier
- Corresponding Engine Family and CARB Executive Order
- Parts and Labor (for Repowers)

For replacement engines greater than <u>135% HP</u>, Funding amount is <u>based on</u> <u>the cost</u> of the new engine/equipment with <u>HP no greater than 135%</u> of existing engine HP



How are Projects Selected for Funding?

Prioritized Population

- Carl Moyer Program (SB 1107) <50% of Program funds
- Community Air Protection (CAP) prioritize projects in AB 617 communities

All projects will be evaluated for benefits to priority population

Remaining projects will compete based on costeffectiveness (tons of emissions/\$ cost of project)



What's Next? Inspections!

Pre-Inspection

- Inspection of the old / existing vehicle or equipment.
- Verifies that the existing equipment is fully operational, matches application data and meets program requirements.
- Occurs after project selection / contracting.
- MUST Occur to receive purchase and destruction approval.

Post-Inspection

- Inspection of the new/repowered vehicle or equipment.
- Verifies that the new equipment meets program requirements.
- Occurs after Pre-Inspection has been approved and new unit has been purchased / delivered.
- MUST be completed to receive invoice payment.

Dismantle/Destruction Inspection

- Inspection of the old vehicle / equipment / engine after it has been destroyed.
- Verifies that the unit and its engine have been destroyed beyond repair per program requirements.
- Occurs after Pre-Inspection has been approved and new unit has been purchased / delivered.
- Destruction MUST occur within 90
 days of receiving new unit.
- Notification MUST be given to SCAQMD in writing upon delivery of old unit to dismantler.
- MUST be completed to receive invoice payment.





- Paper Applications will no longer be accepted




