INTRODUCTION

This document, together with the Draft Subsequent Environmental Impact Report (Draft SEIR) Volumes I, II, and III, and Volume I, II and III of the Final Subsequent Environmental Impact Report (Final SEIR) constitutes the Final SEIR for the proposed Ultramar CARB Phase 3 Proposed Project.

The Draft SEIR was circulated a 45-day for public review and comment period on March 6, 2002 and is otherwise available at the South Coast Air Quality Management District (SCAQMD), 21865 E. Copley Drive, Diamond Bar, California 91765-4182 or by phone at (909) 396-3600. Portions of the DEIR can also be downloaded by contacting the SCAQMD's CEQA web pages at <http://www.aqmd.gov/ceqa/nonaqmd.html>.

The Draft SEIR contained a detailed project description, the environmental setting for each environmental resource where the NOP determined there was a potential significant impact, an analysis of the potentially significant environmental impacts, including cumulative impacts, project alternatives, and other areas of discussion as required by CEQA. The discussion of environmental impacts included a detailed analysis of air quality, geology/soil, hazards and hazardous materials, hydrology/water quality, land use/planning, noise, solid/hazardous waste, and transportation/traffic.

The SCAQMD received about 149 comment letters on the Draft EIR during the public comment period. An additional 41 letters were received after the close of the public comment period. Responses to each comment letter are presented in this Volume. Also, comments received at the June 20, 2002 public meeting are included and responses provided to those comments.
