PURPOSE OF THE MEETINGS

The South Coast Air Quality Management District (South Coast AQMD) has scheduled two Public Consultation Meetings for the purpose of soliciting information, comments, and suggestions from the public, affected businesses, and stakeholders regarding the Coachella Valley Contingency Measure State Implementation Plan (SIP) Revision for the 2008 8-Hour Ozone Standard (Coachella Valley Contingency Measure SIP Revision). The South Coast AQMD

Governing Board will consider the Coachella Valley Contingency Measure SIP Revision at the South Coast AQMD Governing Board meeting on Friday, March 1, 2024. Upon adoption, the package will be submitted to the United States Environmental Protection Agency (U.S. EPA) via California Air Resources Board (CARB) for incorporation into the SIP.

BACKGROUND

The Coachella Valley is classified as an "extreme" nonattainment area for the 2008 8-hour ozone National Ambient Air Quality Standard (NAAQS or standard), with an attainment date of July 20, 2032. The federal Clean Air Act (CAA) requires that SIPs must provide for contingency measures, defined in Section 172(c)(9) as "specific measures to be undertaken if the area fails to make reasonable further progress (RFP), or to attain the national primary ambient air quality standard by the attainment date." Due to a series of court decisions, contingency measures for the Coachella Valley that were submitted in April 2017 are no longer approvable by U.S. EPA.

On August 8, 2022, South Coast AQMD, via CARB, withdrew the contingency measure elements of the Coachella Valley 2008 ozone SIP to avoid disapproval of the submitted contingency measure elements. Effective October 31, 2022, U.S. EPA finalized a finding of failure to submit contingency measure elements of the Coachella Valley 2008 ozone SIP. The SIP deficiency must be corrected to avoid sanctions defined in federal CAA Section 179(b). This proposal provides the revised elements needed to correct this deficiency.

SUMMARY OF PROPOSAL

The Coachella Valley Contingency Measure SIP Revision contains all elements needed to comply with CAA Section 172(c)(9) and U.S. EPA's Draft Guidance. The Coachella Valley Contingency Measure SIP Revision contains a commitment to consider amending Rule 463 - Organic Liquid Storage to include contingency measure elements, which, if triggered, will increase the frequency of Optical Gas Imaging (OGI) inspections for organic liquid storage tanks. In accordance with U.S. EPA's Draft Guidance, the Coachella Valley Contingency Measure SIP Revision includes a robust evaluation demonstrating no other feasible contingency measures exist for the 2008 ozone standard in Coachella Valley. The key elements include:

- Emission inventories (summer planning emissions for the 2031 attainment year);
- A calculation of one year's worth of emission reductions for NOx and VOCs;
- South Coast AQMD's commitment to consider amending Rule 463 to include a stationary source contingency measure;
- South Coast AQMD's stationary source contingency measure infeasibility justification;
- CARB's mobile source contingency measure; and
- CARB's mobile and area source contingency measure infeasibility justifications.
