## South Coast AQMD to host 7<sup>th</sup> Annual Martin Luther King, Jr. Day of Service Luncheon

ABC7's Rachel Brown to serve as Mistress of Ceremonies

**LOS ANGELES** – On Saturday, the South Coast Air Quality Management District (South Coast AQMD) and its Governing Board members will host the seventh annual Martin Luther King, Jr. Day of Service Luncheon in Los Angeles. This year's theme is "Continuing the Legacy through Clean Air for All". The event will commemorate King, Jr.'s commitment to civil rights and equality and will expand the conversation on the need to protect the air we breathe in the South Coast Basin.

The keynote speaker for the event will be Victor Pacheco, Civic Engagement Specialist for the Community Coalition, and ABC7's Rachel Brown will serve as Mistress of Ceremonies. Gloria Walton, President of Strategic Concepts in Organizing and Policy and Education (SCOPE), will be honored with the Environmental Justice for All Award by Chairman of South Coast AQMD's Governing Board, Dr. William A. Burke. The luncheon will also feature musical performances by the Greg Jones Choir.

The event will highlight South Coast AQMD's many environmental justice initiatives and programs such as the Assembly Bill 617 (<u>AB 617</u>) Clean Air Protection Program, the Environmental Justice Community Partnership (<u>EJCP</u>) and the Why Healthy Air Matters (<u>WHAM</u>) High School Air Quality Education Program.
