Rule 2305 – Warehouse Indirect Source Rule – Warehouse Actions and Investments to Reduce Emissions (WAIRE) Program

NOTICE OF DEADLINE UPDATE

Notice to Warehouse Owners and Operators that the Annual WAIRE Report (AWR) Submittal Deadline will be **Monday, February 2, 2026**

As January 31, 2026 falls on a Saturday, the AWR will be deemed timely if submitted on the next business day. Accordingly, the AWR for the 2025 compliance period must be submitted no later than 11:59 p.m. (PST) on Monday, February 2, 2026.

This notice contains general information and may not be applicable to every recipient.

WHAT IS RULE 2305: South Coast Air Quality Management District (South Coast AQMD) adopted [Rule 2305](#) in May 2021 to improve air quality by reducing emissions from warehouses and the vehicles and mobile equipment attracted to warehouses.

APPLICABILITY: Rule 2305 applies to owners and operators of warehouses located in the [South Coast AQMD jurisdiction](#) with at least 100,000 square feet of indoor floor space in a single building.

ANNUAL WAIRE REPORT (AWR): The AWR is a mandatory annual report for applicable warehouse operators, due by January 31 each year, that identifies the actions and investments completed by the warehouse operator in the prior calendar year to comply with rule requirements.

- Reports must be submitted via the [WAIRE Program Online Portal \(WAIRE POP\)](#).
- An AWR is considered complete only after both the certified report and the applicable fee payment are received (see [Rule 316](#) for fee amount).
- Submitting the AWR in advance of the Monday, February 2, 2026 deadline is highly encouraged as response times may be delayed due to a high volume of inquiries.

REQUIRED INFORMATION: The AWR includes the following information:

- Number of truck trips during the compliance period (calendar year 2025) and
- WAIRE Menu actions and/or investments completed by operators to earn WAIRE Points and offset the operator's WAIRE Points Compliance Obligation (WPCO).
