<b>Due Date</b>	Report
September 1, 2021*	<ul> <li>Warehouse owners to submit Warehouse Operations Notification^</li> <li>Owner contact information and whether they are an operator</li> <li>Warehouse information: address and building size</li> <li>Tenant information: contact information and lease start and end dates</li> </ul>

<sup>\*</sup> Or Within 14 days of operator change or 30 days after renovation that changes the square footage

Waterouse Operators Rate 2000 Operating Compilative Date Dates and Obligations	
<b>Due Date</b>	Report/Obligation*
January 31, 2022	<ul> <li>Optional Annual WAIRE Reports (AWR) for Early Action</li> <li>Document early voluntary implementation of WAIRE Menu actions taken in 2021 since rule adoption</li> <li>AWR must be filed by January 31, 2022 to bank Points for future compliance periods</li> </ul>
January 1, 2022 to December 31, 2022	<ul> <li>First compliance period for operators with warehouses ≥ 250,000 square feet</li> <li>Earn WAIRE points</li> <li>AWR must be submitted by January 31, 2023</li> </ul>
July 1, 2022	Operators with warehouses ≥ 250,000 square feet to submit Initial Site Information Report  • From July 2021, operators must begin collecting 12 months of truck trip data (i.e. between July 2021 and June 2022)

<sup>\*</sup>If the warehouse operator vacates the warehouse during the compliance period, the AWR is due the date the operator leaves

<sup>^</sup> Warehouse Operations Notification is the only required reporting obligation for warehouse owners under Rule 2305
