Dear AQMD Members,

We cannot attend the Conference tomorrow and so are sending you our written comments.

We are concerned that the Cooperative Agreement made between AQMD and the LA and Long Beach Ports have ***failed to set clear emission-reduction targets.***

You must realize that if you don't set targets, then significant reductions are unlikely to occur over the coming 5 years of the Agreement.

Please reconsider this mistake and set clear, annual reduction-targets that the Ports must comply with. In addition, define clear and costly consequences for the Ports should they fail to comply with those targets.

It's really the only way you can make progress.

Otherwise your work will be seen as a failure by the taxpayers, and will continue to cause great harm to the public health.
