I live in Long Beach 2 blocks from the ocean and a short distance from the port of Long Beach.

The ports of Los Angeles and Long Beach are together the largest sources of toxic air pollution in Southern California.

Rather than imposing a strict rule re improving air quality, the South Coast AQMD and the Ports have opted for a 5-year Memorandum of Understanding (MOU)

Vague voluntary promises and the Cooperative Agreement that recently went into effect are not enough. We need measurable, enforceable emissions reductions.

I urge you to renegotiate the existing Clean Air Action Plan until the ports finally commit to the aggressive measures needed to truly clear our skies.
