

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

PROPOSED ADOPTION OF, OR AMENDMENT TO, THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE SOUTH COAST AIR QUALITY MANAGEMENT DISTRICT

RE: Proposed Amended Rule 1157 – PM10 Emission Reductions from Aggregate and Related Operations

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that a public hearing on the matter of adoption of rules and regulations for the South Coast Air Quality Management District (South Coast AQMD), or the amendments thereto, will be held on **September 4, 2026** in the Dr. William A. Burke Auditorium at South Coast AQMD Headquarters, 21865 Copley Drive, Diamond Bar, CA at **9:00 a.m.**, or later, at which time evidence will be taken and all interested persons will be heard by the South Coast AQMD Governing Board. The meeting will be conducted through a hybrid format of in-person and/or virtual attendance via videoconferencing and by telephone with opportunities for public comment. NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that the South Coast AQMD is considering the adoption of Proposed Amended Rule 1157 – PM10 Emission Reductions from Aggregate and Related Operations (PAR 1157). The air quality objective of PAR 1157 is to set forth requirements for aggregate and related operations to further reduce particulate matter in the South Coast Air Basin. PAR 1157 expands existing rule provisions, including general performance standards, recordkeeping, and additional requirements triggered by recurrent violations, and rule applicability to include construction and demolition debris transfer stations. Additional proposed amendments will remove outdated provisions, align enforcement practices consistent with other rules, correct references, and improve clarity.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that pursuant to California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) Guidelines Sections 15002(k) and 15061, since installing and maintaining rumble grates and gravel pads at some facilities in response to the proposed project (PAR 1157) will involve minimal construction and maintenance activities, it can be seen with certainty that PAR 1157 would not cause a significant adverse impact on the environment. Thus, PAR 1157 is exempt from CEQA pursuant to CEQA Guidelines Sections 15061(b)(3). A Notice of Exemption will be prepared pursuant to CEQA Guidelines Section 15062, and if the proposed project is approved, the Notice of Exemption will be filed for posting with the county clerks of Los Angeles, Orange, Riverside and San Bernardino counties, and the State Clearinghouse of the Governor's Office of Land Use and Climate Innovation.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that PAR 1157 will not be submitted for inclusion into the State Implementation Plan.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that a written analysis pursuant to Health and Safety Code Section 40727.2 has been prepared that identifies all existing state and federal air pollution control requirements, all existing and proposed South Coast AQMD rules and regulations, and all air pollution control requirements and guidelines that apply to the same equipment or source type as PAR 1157.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that the South Coast AQMD staff will prepare and make available the following documents on or before August 7, 2026, for consideration by the South Coast AQMD Board, including:

- Draft PAR 1157
- Draft Staff Report, which includes Comparative Analysis and the Draft Socioeconomic Impact Assessment

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that at the conclusion of the public hearing, consistent with Health and Safety Code Section 40726, the South Coast AQMD Board may make other modifications to PAR 1157, which are justified by the evidence presented, or may decline to adopt some or all of the proposed amendments.
