Purpose of This Meeting

The South Coast Air Quality Management District (South Coast AQMD) has scheduled a Public Workshop to present and solicit information and suggestions from the public on Proposed Amended Rule 1111 – Reduction of NOx Emissions from Natural-Gas-Fired, Fan-Type Central Furnaces (PAR 1111). PAR 1111 is scheduled for a Public Hearing before the South Coast AQMD Governing Board on January 9, 2026 (subject to change).

Background

Rule 1111 was adopted by the South Coast AQMD Governing Board in December 1978. This rule was amended several times, most recently in 2023. The key changes included lowering the NOx emission limit from 40 to 14 nanograms per Joule (ng/J) in 2009 and providing more time to comply through a mitigation fee alternate compliance option in recent amendments. Condensing, non-condensing, and weatherized furnaces already comply with the 14 ng/J NOx emission limit. For mobile home furnaces, the mitigation fee alternate compliance option ended on September 30, 2025; however, there is limited availability of compliant units.

Objectives of Proposed Amended Rule

PAR 1111 will allow the manufacturers, distributors, sellers, and installers to sell, distribute, and install 40 ng/J mobile home furnaces by extending the mitigation fee alternate compliance option until October 1, 2028.

California Environmental Quality Act

Pursuant to the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) and South Coast AQMD's certified regulatory program (Public Resources Code Section 21080.5 and CEQA Guidelines Section 15251(l); codified in South Coast AQMD Rule 110), the South Coast AQMD, as lead agency, is currently reviewing the proposed project (PAR 1111) to determine if it will result in any potential adverse environmental impacts. Appropriate CEQA documentation will be prepared based on the analysis.
