**Purpose of This Meeting**

The South Coast Air Quality Management District (South Coast AQMD) has scheduled a Public Workshop to present and solicit information and suggestions from the public on Proposed Rule 1110.3 – Emissions from Linear Generators (PR 1110.3) and Proposed Amended Rule 1110.2 – Emissions from Gaseous- and Liquid-Fueled Engines (PAR 1110.2) which are scheduled for a Public Hearing before the South Coast AQMD Governing Board on April 7, 2023 (subject to change).

**Background**

Linear generators are currently regulated under Rule 1110.2. During the 2019 amendment of Rule 1110.2, stakeholders commented on the unique characteristics associated with linear generators. In response to stakeholder comments, staff is developing PR 1110.3 to allow for specific considerations of the technology and capabilities of linear generators.

**Objective of the Proposed and Amended Rules**

PR 1110.3 will establish Oxides of Nitrogen (NOx), Carbon Monoxide (CO), and Volatile Organic Compound (VOC) emission limits for linear generators, as well as provisions for monitoring, reporting, and recordkeeping. PAR 1110.2 will be amended to exempt linear generators and remove applicable requirements.

**California Environmental Quality Act**

Pursuant to the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) and South Coast AQMD's certified regulatory program (Public Resources Code Section 21080.5, CEQA Guidelines Section 15251(l) and South Coast AQMD Rule 110), the South Coast AQMD, as lead agency is currently reviewing the proposed project (PR 1110.3 and PAR 1110.2) to determine if it will result in any potential adverse environmental impacts. Appropriate CEQA documentation will be prepared based on the analysis.
