To be consistent with Governor Newsom’s Executive Order N-29-20 (March 17, 2020) and to ensure safe social distancing is practiced, the Public Workshop will be conducted remotely. Staff will provide a presentation of Proposed Amended Rule 1466 and provide an opportunity for public comments.

**Purpose of This Meeting**

The South Coast Air Quality Management District (South Coast AQMD) has scheduled a Public Workshop on Proposed Amended Rule 1466 – Control of Particulate Emissions from Soils with Toxic Air Contaminants (PAR 1466) to solicit comments from the public. PAR 1466 is scheduled to be considered for adoption at a Public Hearing before the South Coast AQMD Governing Board on May 7, 2021.

**Proposed Amended Rule 1466 Background and Objectives**

Rule 1466 – Control of Particulate Emissions from Soils with Toxic Air Contaminants establishes requirements to minimize fugitive dust emissions from earth-moving activities at sites with soils that contain toxic air contaminants. PAR 1466 will clarify existing provisions; update requirements for pre-approved monitors, and PM<sub>10</sub> monitoring and calculation; enhance dust control measures for vehicle egress, stockpiling, periods of inactivity, and sites adjacent to schools, joint use agreement properties, and adjacent athletic areas; remove alternative provisions for mitigation measures and monitoring; streamline provisions for existing fencing and signage; and add additional requirements for notifications and recordkeeping.

**California Environmental Quality Act**

Pursuant to the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) and South Coast AQMD’s certified regulatory program (Public Resources Code Section 21080.5, CEQA Guidelines Section 15251(l) and South Coast AQMD Rule 110), the South Coast AQMD, as lead agency, is currently reviewing the proposed project (PAR 1466) to determine if it will result in any potential adverse environmental impacts. Appropriate CEQA documentation will be prepared based on the analysis.
