Purpose of this Meeting

The South Coast Air Quality Management District (South Coast AQMD) has scheduled a Public Workshop to present and solicit information and suggestions from the public on Proposed Amended Rule 3002 – Requirements (PAR 3002) which is scheduled for a Public Hearing before the South Coast AQMD Governing Board on January 10, 2025 (subject to change).

Background

Title V facilities are the highest emitting facilities in South Coast AQMD as determined by meeting and/or surpassing the applicable emission thresholds of any pollutants in Rule 3001 – Applicability. Rule 3002 – Requirements establishes requirements for Title V facilities and specifies the conditions for an affirmative defense for non-compliance during an emergency. Rule 3002 also includes greenhouse gas emission provisions that trigger applicability for a facility to obtain a Title V permit, but that are not being implemented due to the U.S. Supreme Court's 2014 decision in *Utility Air Regulation Group v. EPA*. PAR 3002 was initiated in response to the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (U.S. EPA) removing the emergency affirmative defense provisions from Title V operating permit regulations.

Objective of Proposed Amended Rule

PAR 3002 will remove emergency affirmative defense provisions to be consistent with U.S. EPA's Title V operating permit program regulations. PAR 3002 will also remove certain provisions relating to U.S. EPA's greenhouse gas tailoring rule that are not being implemented.

California Environmental Quality Act

Pursuant to the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) and South Coast AQMD's certified regulatory program (Public Resources Code Section 21080.5, CEQA Guidelines Section 15251(l) and South Coast AQMD Rule 110), the South Coast AQMD, as lead agency, is currently reviewing the proposed project (PAR 3002) to determine if it will result in any potential adverse environmental impacts. Appropriate CEQA documentation will be prepared based on the analysis.
