## **RE:** Proposed Amended Regulation XX – Regional Clean Air Incentives Market (RECLAIM)

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that a public hearing on the matter of adoption of rules and regulations for the South Coast Air Quality Management District (SCAQMD), or the amendments thereto, will be held on November 6, 2015 in the Auditorium at SCAQMD Headquarters, 21865 Copley Drive, Diamond Bar, CA 91765, at 9:00 a.m., at which time evidence will be taken and all interested persons will be heard by the SCAQMD Board.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that the SCAQMD is considering the adoption of Proposed Amended Regulation XX – Regional Clean Air Incentives Market (RECLAIM). The proposed amended Regulation XX will implement Control Measure CMB-01 of the 2012 Air Quality Management Plan and make further reductions of nitrogen oxides (NO<sub>x</sub>) from RECLAIM facilities. The proposed amendments implement NO<sub>x</sub> Best Available Retrofit Control (BARCT) for various equipment by establishing RECLAIM Trading Credit (RTC) reduction targets and RTC adjustment factors for year 2016 and beyond. The proposed amendments also introduce a Regional New Source Review (NSR) Holding Account for new power producing facilities, a delay in relative accuracy testing audit (RATA) due dates for specified situations, an allowance for the use of alternate emission factors based on SCAQMD certified equipment exempt from permitting by Rule 219, and other administrative changes. At full implementation the proposed amendments will reduce NO<sub>x</sub> RTCs by 14 tons per day by December 2022.

**NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN** that the proposed amendments to Rule 2002 - Allocations for Oxides of Nitrogen (NOx) and Oxides of Sulfur (SOx), Rule 2005 - New Source Review for RECLAIM, Rule 2011 – Requirements for Monitoring, Reporting, and Recordkeeping for Oxides of Sulfur (SOx) Emissions and Rule 2012 – Requirements for Monitoring, Reporting, and Recordkeeping for Oxides of Nitrogen (NOx) will be submitted to the California Air Resources Board and the United States Environmental Protection Agency for inclusion into the State Implementation Plan.

**NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN** that the Proposed Amendments to Rules 2002, 2005, 2011, and 2012 implement Sections 110, 172, 182(e), and 189 of the Clean Air Act.

**NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN** that a written analysis pursuant to Health and Safety Code Section 40727.2 has been prepared that identifies all existing federal air pollution control requirements, all SCAQMD existing and proposed rules and regulations, and all pollution control requirements and guidelines that apply to the same equipment or source type as the rules proposed for amendment.
