These rules would create a serious financial burden for many residents in my district—working families, seniors on fixed incomes, and small landlords who simply can't afford the steep costs associated with forced electric upgrades. Replacing a broken gas furnace or water heater shouldn't come with a \$10,000+ price tag, yet under these rules, that could be the reality.

Removing gas as an option puts families at risk of losing heat or hot water during grid failures, especially in extreme weather conditions.

These rules are being rushed without enough public awareness or financial support, and the consequences will fall hardest on those who can least afford them.

I urge the board to vote no on June 6 or, at the very least, delay adoption until more outreach and community input can take place. There are cleaner technologies and better paths forward that don't involve punishing working-class residents.
