Members of the South Coast Air Quality Management District Board:

I apologize for my tardy input in advance of the meeting tomorrow about Proposed Rules 1111 and 1121. I cannot attend the meeting either in person or via Zoom. Please consider my written comments below even though I missed the Tuesday deadline.

I strongly urge passage of these necessary measures to address our deteriorating air quality in Southern California generally, and specifically here in the Coachella Valley, where heat, dust, wind, topography, aggressive leaf-blowing, and a general ignorance of how bad the air is and why renders our atmosphere particularly egregious.

No one wants to be deprived of making personal decisions, but being forced into the transition to all-electric appliances is less offensive and less of a hardship now than an unlivable planet will be within only a generation. For decades, we — the community, the state, the nation, the world — have been slovenly in resolving climate change. Fossil fuels' contribution to poor air and global warming must be curtailed with dispatch. As long as there are provisions to assist those lacking resources to replace their NOX-producing appliances, everyone must take responsibility for correcting our past dereliction. No one is excluded from planet restoration and maintenance, and the more we do now, the less pain we will suffer later.

Approve the proposed rule amendments to phase out gas appliances. It's difficult, but it's the proper, and critical, thing to do.

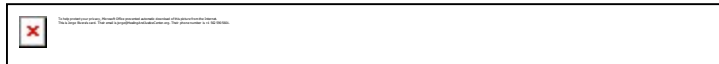

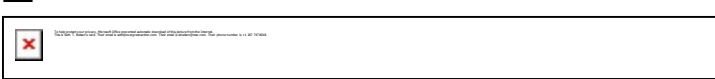
