RULE 480. NATURAL GAS FIRED CONTROL DEVICES

- (a) A person installing or using an Air Pollution Control Device which operates on natural gas shall provide one of the following:
 - (1) A plan, subject to the approval of the Executive Officer which will cause the equipment or source generating the emissions to be taken out of service during a natural gas shortage or curtailment, until approved fuel is restored to the Air Pollution Control Device; or
 - (2) A fuel system approved by the Executive Officer for use during a natural gas shortage or curtailment.

- (b) Effective Dates
 - (1) This rule becomes effective on the date of adoption for any equipment subject to the provisions of this rule which is installed or constructed on or after that date.
 - (2) The owner or operator of any equipment subject to the provisions of this rule, which has been installed or constructed prior to the adoption, shall by December 31, 1977, submit:
 - (A) A plan describing at a minimum the steps that will be taken to achieve compliance with the provisions of this rule, or
 - (B) An application for Permit to Construct if the equipment is to be modified.
