Mr. Johnson is a senior manager with extensive experience in Engineering, Planning and Environmental Services. He has over 30 years experience in environmental management, civil and environmental engineering, planning, construction, and construction management. For the past 20 years, Mr. Johnson's professional responsibilities have focused primarily on the transportation industry.

Mr. Johnson has held increasingly responsible management positions within both the public and private sector over the past 20 years including Deputy Executive Director of Technology, Facilities and Environmental Planning for Los Angeles World Airports, and managing the aviation division for an international Engineering, Planning and Environmental consulting firm. Mr. Johnson has provided technical services to over 150 airports across the United States, Europe and Asia.

In his current position as the Deputy Executive Director for Facilities and Environmental Planning with Los Angeles World Airports, a department of the City of Los Angeles, Mr. Johnson's duties include oversight of all Engineering, Planning, Facilities, Regional Transportation Planning and Environmental Planning for the four airports owned by the City of Los Angeles, development of the department-wide sustainability program and Environmental Management System, and planning support services related to the LAX, LA/ONT and LA/PMD master plans. Mr. Johnson has been with LAWA since 2006, and also served an earlier stint with LAWA from 2000-2003 as Deputy Executive Director for Technology and Environmental Affairs. He performed duties similar to his current role, as well as overseeing the integration of the Information Technology and Telecommunications Division into a consolidated IT Division.

Mr. Johnson's other professional experience includes serving as the Vice President and Technical Services Manager for Camp Dresser & McKee Inc, an international consulting firm with over \$1 billion in annual revenue. Working with CDM from 1987 to 2000 and again from 2003 to 2006, he was responsible for management of the Aviation, Planning and Environmental Services Division, provided technical oversight, staffing, and project delivery support for aviation projects in the US, Europe and Asia, was responsible for marketing and business development, staffing, employee development and division profit and loss, and personally managed engineering, planning and environmental projects for multiple aviation clients including Los Angeles World Airports, San Diego International Airport, Phoenix Sky Harbor International, Atlanta Hartsfield International Airport, New York John F. Kennedy International Airport, Newark International Airport, and Denver International Airport.
