

Dr. Dongmin Luo - Bio

Dr. Dongmin Luo is manager of the Air Quality and Climate Change Section in Research Division, California Air Resources Board. He has over 15-year experiences in air pollution research, atmospheric reactivity, vehicle emissions, air toxics, alternative fuels, and climate science. He has been the lead in providing technical support on reactivity-based programs in California. Prior to joining in CARB, he was a research scientist at College of Engineering-Center for Environmental Research and Technology at the University of California, Riverside.

He received both M.S. and Ph.D. in Environmental Engineering (air pollution control) from Kyoto University, Japan. He was a postdoctoral research chemist under the supervision of Dr. William Carter and conducted research on atmospheric reactivity of VOCs in Statewide Air Pollution Research Center, UCR. He is a registered professional engineer (chemical engineering) in California and an adjunct professor of air pollution research.
